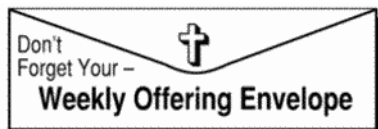

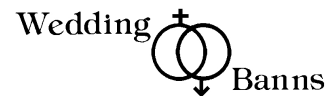
**Baptism Class**
