Rosary – Rosary is held at 8:00 AM on weekdays when morning Masses are celebrated.

Baptisms – The 2nd & 4th Sunday of the month at 12:00 PM. Parents are required to attend Pre-Baptism Class. Arrangements must be made a minimum of 2 weeks prior to the date of baptism.

The month of November presents us with some special opportunities to remember and give thanks for the blessings that our Lord has bestowed on us.

This year, **All Saints Day**, falls on Saturday, November 1st, and is NOT a Holyday of Obligation.

Mass will be celebrated for **All Souls** on Saturday at the 4:00 pm vigil Mass and 7:00 pm Bereavement Mass, and Sunday at 9 am and 11 am.

We will gather as a community to remember and give thanks for our loved ones who have died. The names of those who have died since last All Saints Day to the present will be displayed on the altar and families will be invited to light candles in remembrance, at our Annual Bereavement Mass. Prayers will be offered for our departed loved ones that they may enter into Heaven, as well as for the consolation of their families.

Please turn in your **All Souls envelopes** with the names of your loved ones who have died. Once again, their names will be placed on the altar during the month of November and we will remember them in prayer.

On the weekend of November 8th and 9th, members of our St. Vincent de Paul Society will address our parish community and a **second collection** will be taken to serve the poor in our midst. **Thursday, November 27th** at 9:00 am, we will celebrate our **Thanksgiving Mass**. Once again we will collect canned goods and paper products for the poor. These items can be brought to church and placed in collections boxes on the altar. Our **Thanksgiving collection** will also go to our St. Vincent de Paul Society to help the poor.

As we continue our **Stewardship Program**, we remember and give thanks for God's Blessings. With grateful hearts, we donate our time, talent, and treasure. If you have not already done so, please return your Commitment and Pledge envelopes by mail or through the offertory collection. Everyone is asked to consider increasing their financial contributions to support the ministries at St. John Nepomucene Parish. The recommended increase is 1 percent of your gross annual income before deductions...but for those who cannot do this, any amount would be deeply appreciated.

May we all respond to these invitations to remember and give thanks.
