**Sick Calls** – Please notify the rectory office to bring the Sacraments when a member of your family is hospitalized. Call the parish office or our Pastoral Minister, Heidi Madsen

**Rosary** – Rosary is held at 8:00 AM on weekdays when morning Masses are celebrated.

**Baptisms** – The 2nd & 4th Sunday of the month at 12:00 pm. Parents are required to attend Pre-Baptism Class. Arrangements must be made a minimum of 2 weeks prior to the date of baptism.

**Baptism Class**- Before you baptize your child, parish and diocesan policy require you to complete a **Baptism Preparation Class**. The next class will be held **June 6, 2010** at Holy Name Parish at 1 pm. Call 271-4242 to register. There are no classes scheduled in May.

**Godparent and Sponsor Certificate** – Sponsors for Baptism or Confirmation must be **registered** and practicing members of the Church, attending weekly and Holy Day Masses for a minimum of 3 months prior to the celebration of the Sacraments for which they have requested the certificate. If you attend mass, but are not registered, please contact our parish office so that you can be registered here.

### **Must you receive the anointing of the sick to get to heaven?**

At conferences on spirituality and healing in medicine, doctors are reporting the positive effects of faith and prayer on healing and wellness through studies and personal observation. The clinical studies can measure the effects of what is happening. What they cannot measure is God's grace, which comes to us in many ways to heal, sanctify and comfort. The essential sacrament of "healing" is baptism, which frees us from the grasp of death through a birth to eternal life. This is what ultimately heals us in the sense that sin can no longer harm us or destroy us.

The anointing of the sick is not necessary for one to get to heaven. In fact, many Catholics never receive it. But it does channel God's healing grace to us in a special way to help us in our moments of weakness. It protects us from despair and offers the consolation of God's loving providence through the prayers of the church and the ministry of the priest. That is a power beyond measuring!

The anointing of the sick is a sacrament for the sick, with a prayer for healing, not a sacrament for those close to death (that's viaticum-Communion "on the way"). If you're chronically ill, anticipating surgery, or in a hospital or nursing home, ask your parish priest for this healing grace.
