Sick Calls – Please notify the rectory office to bring the Sacraments when a member of your family is hospitalized. Call the parish office or our Pastoral Minister, Heidi Madsen

Rosary – Rosary is held at 8:00 AM on weekdays when morning Masses are celebrated.

Baptisms – The 2nd & 4th Sunday of the month at 12:00 pm. Parents are required to attend Pre-Baptism Class. Arrangements must be made a minimum of 2 weeks prior to the date of baptism.

Baptism Class- Before you baptize your child, parish and diocesan policy require you to complete a **Baptism Preparation Class**. The next class will be held **June 6, 2010** at Holy Name Parish at 1 pm. Call 271-4242 to register. There are no classes scheduled in May.

Godparent and Sponsor Certificate – Sponsors for Baptism or Confirmation must be **registered** and practicing members of the Church, attending weekly and Holy Day Masses for a minimum of 3 months prior to the celebration of the Sacraments for which they have requested the certificate. If you attend mass, but are not registered, please contact our parish office so that you can be registered here.

Pre -Cana Program for couples anticipating the Sacrament of Marriage will be held at the Jesuit Retreat House on **June 20, 2010 at 12:45 pm**. Stewardship Corner
Pentecost Sunday



“To each individual the manifestation of the Spirit is given for some benefit.” 1Cor 12:3b-7, 12-13
It has been seven weeks and one day since Easter Sunday. It is Pentecost (from the Greek word for “fiftieth”), the day on which the Holy Spirit encouraged the Apostles to proclaim Jesus Christ to people from many nations, cultures, languages and religious beliefs. Each person heard the Apostles in his or her own tongue. Amazing! Even more amazing is that people with a variety of religious beliefs came to believe in Jesus. Later, Paul writes to Christians in Corinth, a very diverse seaport city, and he tells them something so obvious we often forget it: Each of us is a person with a unique array of talents, abilities and gifts that God has given to us to use for ourselves and for others-material wealth, intelligence, musical and artistic talent, athletic ability, and many others. God intends for us to enjoy them ourselves and to share them with others. How are we doing with that? One day God will ask.
