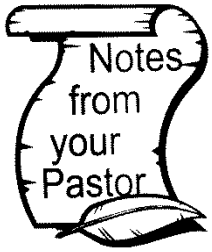
Sick Calls – Please call the rectory to arrange for Father Jasany to bring the Sacraments when a member of your family is hospitalized.

Weddings – Parishioners are asked to call the rectory office at least 6 months in advance of the wedding to schedule an appointment with Father Jasany.

Baptisms – The 1st & 3rd Sunday of the month at 12:00 pm. Parents are required to attend Pre-Baptism Class. Arrangements must be made a minimum of 2 weeks prior to the date of baptism. Before parents baptize their child, Diocesan and parish policy requires you to complete a Baptism Preparation Class. **The next class will be on Wednesday, February 8th at St. Stanislaus Parish at 7 pm.** Reservations needed; please call 216-641-2829 to register.

Godparent and Sponsor Certificate – Sponsors for Baptism or Confirmation must be registered and practicing members of the Church, attending weekly and Holy Day Masses for a minimum of 3 months prior to the celebration of the Sacraments for which they have requested the certificate. Please note individuals 18 years of age and older, no longer in school, need to register.

This weekend, February 4th and 5th we will celebrate the traditional blessing of throats after the homily. This prayer for healing is linked with devotion to St. Blaise, Bishop and Martyr. When St. Blaise was being led away to be martyred, a mother brought a child who was choking, possibly on a fishbone, to him. St. Blaise prayed over the child and miraculously, the bone was dislodged.

The child was no longer choking. Since the 8th century, St. Blaise has been venerated as the patron saint of those who suffer from diseases of the throat. During this weekend, we pray in a special way for protection from afflictions of the throat and all other illnesses. Through the intercession of St. Blaise we will pray for healing for everyone present. Everyone can come forward at our weekend Masses to receive this healing prayer.

We will also remember those who are ill in hospitals, nursing homes and in their own homes.

May Our Blessed Lord extend His Healing Hands toward us.

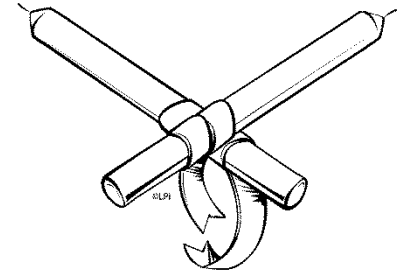

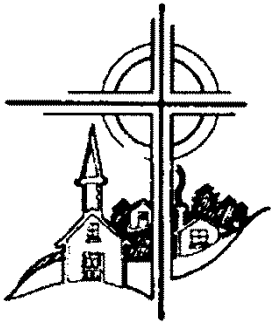

What would you do with an extra \$1000????

Our parish has a monthly \$1000 raffle and we are looking for individuals interested in purchasing a monthly book of tickets. Over the past few years we have lost book sellers and book buyers.

We print 420 books monthly. The money we have raise from the \$1000 raffle goes towards the preservation & maintenance of our buildings and grounds.



We have a main prize of \$1000.00, a \$100.00 seller prize and five \$10.00 consolation prizes. A book of tickets costs \$5.00. Our drawing is always held on the fourth Sunday of the month after our 11 AM Mass. The drawing is held in our school building lobby. Winners do not need to be present, you will notified by phone. The monthly raffle tickets are usually given out the first Sunday after the drawing. There is always an announcement at Mass for you to pick up your tickets in the school building foyer. You can also pick up your raffle tickets at the rectory or we can mail them to you. In addition, you can prepay for several months in advance and I will fill out the monthly stubs for you.

Returns may be made by dropping your envelope in the collection basket at the weekend masses. You may also drop your tickets off at the rectory office or mail them in. If you have not made your return by the day of the drawing, you can stop in the school lobby before the drawing and give them to me.

So please consider purchasing a \$5.00 book of tickets. Imagine if each of our parishioners could purchase just 1 book of tickets a month!
