We are not able to schedule any funerals for Monday, July 10<sup>th</sup> or Tuesday, July 11<sup>th</sup>. If the need occurs we could hold a funeral at a neighboring parish. The weekday Masses will be cancelled for July 11<sup>th</sup>, 13<sup>th</sup> & 14<sup>th</sup> to give us extra days in case of inclement weather. Our parking lot entrances will be chained to prevent people from driving over the sealing job On Monday, July 10<sup>th</sup> and the striping job on Tuesday, July 11<sup>th</sup>. Please be aware of this so that you do not damage your cars or the parking lot. Please do not leave any vehicles parked in our lot on Monday, July 10<sup>th</sup>.

Our annual Parish Picnic is Saturday, August 26<sup>th</sup> at Klima Gardens. We have finished the outside work on the tuck-pointing and the towers. I am now taking estimates on the choir loft ceiling. The total cost of this project – Towers, Tuck-pointing and Choir loft ceiling is projected at \$181,655.00. 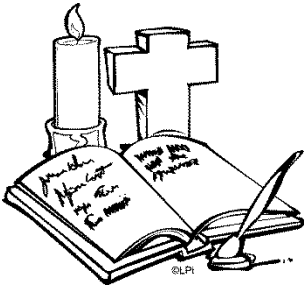

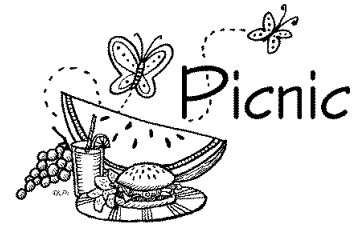

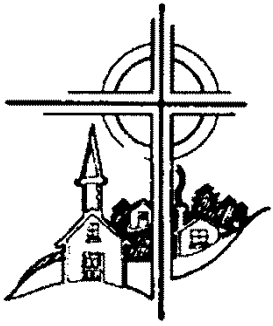
