Sick Calls – Please call the rectory to arrange for Father Jasany to bring the Sacraments when a member of your family is hospitalized.

Weddings – Parishioners are asked to call the rectory office at least 6 months in advance of the wedding to schedule an appointment with Father Jasany.

Baptisms – The 1st & 3rd Sunday of the month at 12:00 pm. Parents are required to attend Pre-Baptism Class. Arrangements must be made a minimum of 2 weeks prior to the date of baptism. Before parents baptize their child, Diocesan and parish policy requires you to complete a Baptism Preparation Class. **The next class will be on Sunday, September 13th at Immaculate Heart Parish at 1:30 pm.** Reservations needed; please call 216-341-1274 to make your reservation.

Godparent and Sponsor Certificate – Sponsors for Baptism or Confirmation must be registered and practicing members of the Church, attending weekly and Holy Day Masses for a minimum of 3 months prior to the celebration of the Sacraments for which they have requested the certificate. Please note individuals 18 years of age and older, no longer in school, need to register.

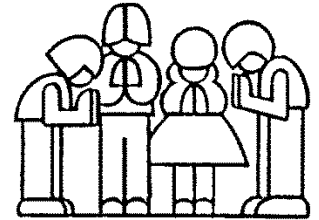

New this school year, St. Edward High School; 13500 Detroit Avenue is accepting the Cleveland Scholarship Program voucher. A recent change to state law now allows private high schools in certain cities adjacent to the city of Cleveland to accept the Cleveland Scholarship Program voucher. Lakewood meets the standard. The value of the voucher for grades 9-12 is currently \$5700 per year, which can be applied to the tuition at St. Edward's. Also, families may still apply for need-based financial aid to help cover the remaining cost of tuition. Applications for financial aid will be available this fall during Admission tests. Families who wish to apply for the voucher or renew it for the 2016-17 school at St. Edward must first apply for admission. Cleveland residents accepted for admission to St. Edward will receive additional information about how to apply for the voucher or renew an existing one.
