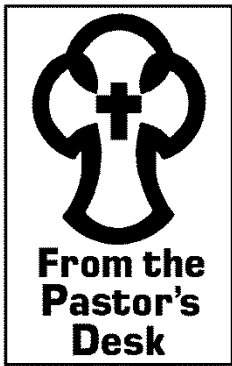
Sick Calls – Please call the rectory to arrange for Father Jasany to bring the Sacraments when a member of your family is hospitalized.

Weddings – Parishioners are asked to call the rectory office at least 6 months in advance of the wedding to schedule an appointment with Father Jasany.

Baptisms – The 1st & 3rd Sunday of the month at 12:00 pm. Parents are required to attend Pre-Baptism Class. Arrangements must be made a minimum of 2 weeks prior to the date of baptism. Before parents baptize their child, Diocesan and parish policy requires you to complete a Baptism Preparation Class. **The next class will be on Sunday, November 6th at St. John Nepomucene Parish at 12:30 pm.** Reservations needed; please call 216-641-8444 to register.

Godparent and Sponsor Certificate – Sponsors for Baptism or Confirmation must be registered and practicing members of the Church, attending weekly and Holy Day Masses for a minimum of 3 months prior to the celebration of the Sacraments for which they have requested the certificate. Please note individuals 18 years of age and older, no longer in school, need to register.

November is a wonderful month to remember, to give thanks and to share our blessings.

We celebrate All Saints Day, which is a holy day

of obligation this year. We will have a 4 pm Vigil Mass on Monday, October 31st. We will have Mass at 8:30 am and 7 pm on Tuesday, November 1st. We remember all the saints, those who are famous and those who are not so famous, among them are loved ones who have shined the Light of Christ for us.

Saturday, November 5th is our Annual Bereavement Mass at 4 pm. We will remember those who passed away from November 1, 2015 thru October 31, 2016 at this Mass. The families of those who died during this time period are invited to attend and encouraged to light a candle in memory of their deceased loved one. Afterwards, there will be a social in the parish hall. Family members are asked to call the rectory at 216-641-8444 and let us know whether or not you are attending this Mass and Social. Our parish community is invited to attend to support those who are suffering the loss of a loved one in death.

Please remember to place your All Souls envelopes with the names of your deceased loved ones in the offertory basket. We place these envelopes with the names of the deceased in a basket on the Altar of Sacrifice. We remember them in prayer during November at all our masses.

We also schedule a monthly All Souls mass for them throughout the year.

I am very grateful to those who are paying on their pledges for the Rooted in Faith, Forward in Hope Campaign. We are using these donations to help defray the cost of the exterior work on our church. 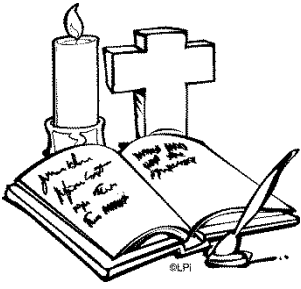

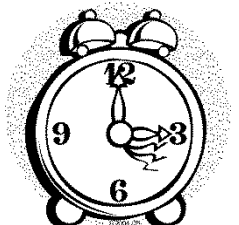
