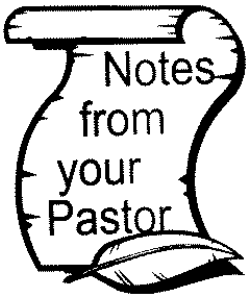
Sick Calls – Please call the rectory to arrange for Father Jasany to bring the Sacraments when a member of your family is hospitalized.

Weddings – Parishioners are asked to call the rectory office at least 6 months in advance of the wedding to schedule an appointment with Father Jasany.

Baptisms – The 1st & 3rd Sunday of the month at 12:00 pm. Parents are required to attend Pre-Baptism Class. Arrangements must be made a minimum of 2 weeks prior to the date of baptism. Before parents baptize their child, Diocesan and parish policy requires you to complete a Baptism Preparation Class. **The next class will be on Sunday, March 5th at Immaculate Heart Parish at 1:30 pm.** Reservations needed; please call 216-341-2734 to register.

Godparent and Sponsor Certificate – Sponsors for Baptism or Confirmation must be registered and practicing members of the Church, attending weekly and Holy Day Masses for a minimum of 3 months prior to the celebration of the Sacraments for which they have requested the certificate. Please note individuals 18 years of age and older, no longer in school, need to register.

Dear Parishioners,

Lent is around the corner. March 1st is Ash Wednesday. Our Stewardship Commission has

suggested that we are called to the Table of the Word, the Table of the Eucharist, and the Table of Information during the Holy Season of Lent.

First Week of Lent – Called to Community.

Our friendship with the Risen Jesus begins when He personally invites us to follow Him and become His friend. His invitation demands our wholehearted response.

Second Week of Lent – Called to

Commitment. We commit ourselves both to Jesus and to our Parish community. This creates the bond of faith. We trust Him and entrust ourselves to Him and we commit ourselves to one another as a community of believers and followers.

Third Week of Lent – Called to

Co-Mission. We dedicate ourselves to continuing Jesus' work of creating a community of followers who embody in their lives the right relationships to God and one another that Jesus desired.

Fourth Week of Lent – Called to

Challenge. We strive daily to live more responsibly according to Jesus' vision and values and to fulfill the obligations in our relationship with Him and in our relationship with others in the community of disciples.

Fifth Week of Lent – Called to Conversion.

We change our attitudes, behaviors and values in order to turn toward God and away from the evil forces that dominate our world.

Holy Week – Called to Courage.

We courageously accept the consequences of trying to be like Jesus and continuing His work of overcoming evil in our world today.

During these weeks, the Table of Information will highlight Community, Commitment, Co-Mission, Challenge, Conversion and Courage. These themes, we are being called upon to pray over and then to take action steps in implementing these themes.

I look forward to making the upcoming Lenten journey with you.

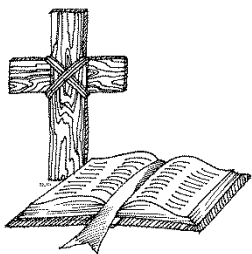
