

# FROM THE PASTOR

Dear Parishioners,

This weekend we celebrate the Descent of the Holy Spirit upon the Apostles and on us. The Blessed Virgin Mary had a special relationship with the Holy Spirit. Through the power of the Holy Spirit, she conceived our Savior and Lord, Jesus Christ.

Periodically, Mary has appeared on the earth to invite us to return to God. Mary appeared six times in Fatima, Portugal; May 13<sup>th</sup> to October 13<sup>th</sup>, 1917 to three shepherd children. Briefly stated, she appeared during World War I to give us a peace plan for our world and for our individual lives.

This is a special Jubilee Year, which celebrates the 100<sup>th</sup> Anniversary of the apparitions of Our Lady of Fatima. In celebration of this year, a plenary indulgence of the jubilee will be granted to those who devotedly make a pilgrimage to the Shrine of Fatima in Portugal, Fatima. In addition, the jubilee plenary indulgence may be granted in the following two ways:

1. To the pious faithful who visit with devotion an image of Our Lady of Fatima solemnly displayed for public veneration in the temple, oratory or adequate place, during the day of the anniversary of the apparitions (the 13<sup>th</sup> of each month from

May to October 2017) and devotedly participate there in any celebration of the Virgin Mary, pray the Our Father, recite the Profession of Faith (Creed) and invoke Our Lady of Fatima.

We will have a special celebration on June 13<sup>th</sup> with a Mass at 7 pm and a rosary in our church. The Diocesan Pilgrim Virgin Statue of Our Lady of Fatima will be present.

2. To the faithful who due to their age, disease or other serious reason are impeded of moving, if repentant of all their sins and having the firm intention of performing as soon as possible, the three conditions mentioned below, in front of a small image of Our Lady of Fatima, spiritually unite in the days of the apparitions to the Jubilee celebrations, offering with trust to God all merciful through Mary their prayers and pains, or the sacrifices of their own lives.

To obtain the plenary indulgence, the faithful, truly penitent and animated with charity, must ritually fulfill the following conditions – Sacramental confession, Eucharistic communion and Prayer for the intentions of the Holy Father.

Invocation of Our Lady of Fatima may be made with the following prayer:

O God, who chose the Mother of your Son to be our Mother also, for the salvation of the world, we may further effectively each day the reign of Christ, who lives and reigns for ever and ever. Amen.

In addition to this special celebration June 13<sup>th</sup> for the granting of the plenary indulgence (which is further described on the insert in our bulletin), there are other opportunities to celebrate this special year in honor of Our Lady of Fatima.

We have First Saturday Devotions on the First Saturday of the month at 3:15 pm in our church. We also have the Fatima Cell Hour of Holiness at 12:30 pm in our church on the second Sunday of the month.

Finally, we are having a Fatima Centennial Conference July 28<sup>th</sup>-29<sup>th</sup>, 2017 at the Embassy Suites Cleveland Rockside. For more information visit <a href="https://www.neofatimaconf.com">www.neofatimaconf.com</a> or call 440-241-5788.
