

Sick Calls – Please call the rectory to arrange for Father Jasany to bring the Sacraments when a member of your family is hospitalized.

Weddings – Parishioners are asked to call the rectory office at least 6 months in advance of the wedding to schedule an appointment with Father Jasany.

Baptisms – The 1st & 3rd Sunday of the month at 12:00 pm. Parents are required to attend Pre-Baptism Class. Arrangements must be made a minimum of 2 weeks prior to the date of baptism. Before parents baptize their child, Diocesan and parish policy requires you to complete a Baptism Preparation Class. **The next class will be on Sunday, July 16th at St. John Nepomucene Parish at 12:30 pm.** Reservations needed; please call 216-641-8444 to register.

Godparent and Sponsor Certificate – Sponsors for Baptism or Confirmation must be registered and practicing members of the Church, attending weekly and Holy Day Masses for a minimum of 3 months prior to the celebration of the Sacraments for which they have requested the certificate. Please note individuals 18 years of age and older, no longer in school, need to register.

Cardinal Asphalt is doing the parking lot Monday, July 10th and Tuesday, July 11th. So the parking lot will be closed on those two days. No one is supposed to go over the sealing job for 24 hours. No one is supposed to go over the striping job until after it dries.

The weekday Masses will be cancelled for July 11th, 13th & 14th to give us extra days in case of inclement weather. Our parking lot entrances will be chained to prevent people from driving over the sealing job on Monday, July 10th and the striping job on Tuesday, July 11th. Please be aware of this so that you do not damage your cars or the parking lot. Please do not leave any vehicles parked in our lot on Monday, July 10th.

If a funeral needs to be scheduled for Monday, July 10th or Tuesday, July 11th we will make arrangements to hold it at a neighboring parish.

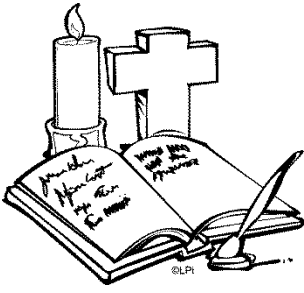
