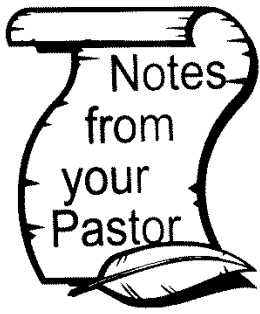

I look forward to celebrating with you at our Annual Parish Picnic on Saturday, August 26<sup>th</sup> at Klima Gardens in Cuyahoga

Hts. The parish picnic begins with our 4 pm Mass on the picnic grounds.

Consequently the 4 pm Mass in our church is cancelled for Saturday, August 26<sup>th</sup>.

God has placed all of us together for a reason, so that we can form a community in Christ. It is good for us to enjoy the Presence of Christ and the presence of one another. God willing, I will have the choir loft ceiling done in the fall. I am waiting to hear the exact cost from Paul Davis Restoration Company and waiting to hear the final confirmation of what the Diocesan insurance will pay (due to a claim on water damage). Hopefully, this will be completed this year.

Please consider using the Touch Up the Towers envelope and memorial gift envelope for this cause. I am grateful for our custom of making memorial gifts in honor of our loved ones who have died. It is a way to honor their generosity. Our parish has been built upon the prayers and sacrifices of good people; may the prayers and sacrifices continue in us.

I received some very good news from Catholic Charities. We surpassed our goal for Catholic Charities. Our goal was \$12,491.00; our total pledged thus far is \$12,609.00. This represents 29% of our parish who participated in helping us reach our goal. I thank Jan Vitt, who helps co-ordinate and organize this endeavor. She is a blessing to us and to those in need.

God gave most of us two hands; with one hand we reach out to God in prayer and with the other hand we reach out to our brothers and sisters.

I ask everyone to make an effort come to enjoy our parish picnic. Enjoy time in prayer, the music, the food, the fellowship. I hope to see all of you at the picnic next weekend. Everyone is welcome to attend. Invite your friends, relatives, co-workers and classmates to come as well. May God bless us with a good time together!

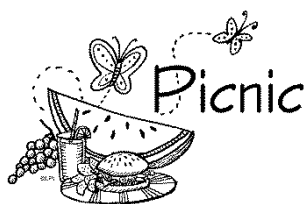
