Sick Calls – Please call the rectory to arrange for Father Jasany to bring the Sacraments when a member of your family is hospitalized.

Weddings – Parishioners are asked to call the rectory office at least 6 months in advance of the wedding to schedule an appointment with Father Jasany.

Baptisms – The 1st & 3rd Sunday of the month at 12:00 pm. Parents are required to attend Pre-Baptism Class. Arrangements must be made a minimum of 2 weeks prior to the date of baptism. Before parents baptize their child, Diocesan and parish policy requires you to complete a Baptism Preparation Class. **The next class will be on Wednesday, November 8th at St. Stanislaus Parish at 7 pm.** Reservations needed; please call 216-341-9091 to register.

Godparent and Sponsor Certificate – Sponsors for Baptism or Confirmation must be registered and practicing members of the Church, attending weekly and Holy Day Masses for a minimum of 3 months prior to the celebration of the Sacraments for which they have requested the certificate. Please note individuals 18 years of age and older, no longer in school, need to register.

This weekend we celebrate World Mission Sunday. Archbishop Sheen said "Some people give to the missions by going; others go

to Missions by giving." Please use the envelope in your packet for this worthy cause.

Did you know that every Roman Catholic Christian is called to be a missionary to the people whom he or she meets?

There is a poem that goes something like this:

"You are writing a Gospel a chapter a day,
By what you do and what you say.
Now, whatever you say or whatever you do,
whether distorted or true,
What is the Gospel according to you?"

When Jesus walked the earth, Our Lord personally invited people to follow Him. As followers of Christ, we too are called to invite people in our circle to come to Jesus.

It would be noble and worthwhile for you to begin with your family, relatives, friends classmates and co-workers. You could say I am going to Mass, would you like to come with me? I am going to confession, would you like to come with me? Our church is having an event, would you like to come?

One imaginary scenario of the Last Judgement is this...You standing before Our Blessed Lord and Christ asking you who did you bring with you? How do you bring people to Christ?

It is by extending an invitation. You can always invite; do not invest your self esteem in the response. Life about the Sower and the seed. Send out seeds of invitations that can grow.

Where do I begin? You begin with your own family, your own relatives, your own friends, your classmates and co-workers.

Pray to the Holy Spirit. Ask the Spirit to guide and direct you. Pray Holy Spirit, is there someone who I am called to invite to come to Jesus? Act on the intuitions that come to your mind and the promptings that come to your heart.

In the final analysis that is what life here is about. Coming to Jesus and inviting other people to come to Jesus.

May God open your hearts to extend this important invitation to the people whom God has placed in your lives. Together may we all extend this most important invitation.
