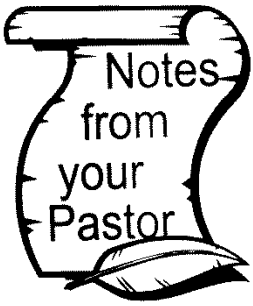



The American Legion Riders are hosting an AUCE Pancake Breakfast today from 8 am – Noon. To be held at Post 627;

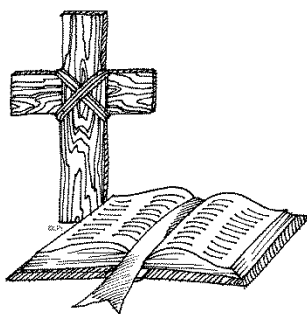
