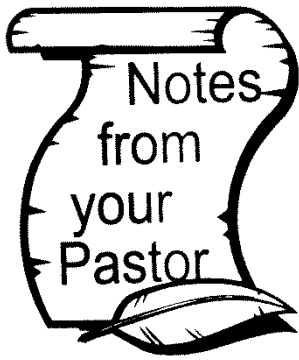
Sick Calls – Please call the rectory to arrange for Father Jasany to bring the Sacraments when a member of your family is hospitalized.

Weddings – Parishioners are asked to call the rectory office at least 6 months in advance of the wedding to schedule an appointment with Father Jasany.

Baptisms – The 1st & 3rd Sunday of the month at 12:00 pm. Parents are required to attend Pre-Baptism Class. Arrangements must be made a minimum of 2 weeks prior to the date of baptism. Before parents baptize their child, Diocesan and parish policy requires you to complete a Baptism Preparation Class. **The next class will be on Wednesday, October 3rd at St. Stanislaus Parish at 7 pm.** Reservations needed; please call 216-341-9091 to register.

Godparent and Sponsor Certificate – Sponsors for Baptism or Confirmation must be registered and practicing members of the Church, attending weekly and Holy Day Masses for a minimum of 3 months prior to the celebration of the Sacraments for which they have requested the certificate. Please note individuals 18 years of age and older, no longer in school, need to register.

Dear Parishioners,
October is a month dedicated to Mary. At Fatima Portugal on October 13, 1917, Our Blessed Mother identified herself as "Our Lady of the

Rosary." All are invited to participate in A Mile For Mary, which includes a Eucharistic Procession with Rosary in reparation for sins committed against the Immaculate Heart of Mary. The day will begin with an 8 am Mass at St. Charles Parish in Parma on Saturday, October 13th. Afterwards, there will be a Eucharistic Procession with rosary. We will walk to St. Francis de Sales Church, where we will have Eucharistic Exposition, a talk by Mark Moran, Benediction of the Blessed Sacrament and refreshments. Everyone is warmly invited and encouraged to attend.

We are having a special Alumni Mass on Saturday, October 20th at 4 pm in our church. There will be a social in our hall following the mass. Please see the flyer in this weekend's bulletin. Please fill out the form and drop it in the collection basket or return it to the rectory office. This is a great way to reconnect with your classmates from previous years.

Monday, October 1st – We commence with an insurance project on our church building. There is one claim with two parts.

Briefly stated:

1. An ice jam on the East 50th side of the church caused interior paint and plaster damage in the upper and middle portions

of two side columns and part of the ceiling. Insurance will cover the interior paint damage. We will pay for the outside roof repair which includes a defrosting wire to prevent future damage from occurring.

2. Storm water came in through the Rose window and caused interior paint damage below the window behind the choir loft and interior damage on the white arch in the vestibule. Frost Preservation will re-caulk the outside of the window. Paul Davis Restoration will take care of the inside painting in both areas. The scaffolding will go up in the church on Monday, October 2nd.

During the month of October, may all of use commit ourselves to praying a five-decade rosary every day. This was the request of Our Lady of Fatima for peace in our lives and peace in our world. May many of us consider participating in the mile walk for Mary and may many of us come to our Alumni Mass.

Let us open our hearts to these opportunities to reconnect with God and with one another.
